The Music of Dolphins by: Karen Hesse

Mila is trying to learn how to speak and write like a human! She was raised by a family of dolphins off the coast of Cuba. Mila soon is picked up by the Coast Guard and is forced to teach Doctor Beck and Sandy the language of the dolphins. She becomes a walking science experiment!

Recommendations: I would suggest this book to anybody in fifth grade or older and to those who love dolphin stories!

The Hunger Games by: Suzanne Collins

A crystal ball that holds her name, a small shot at fortune and fame, and a game where you have to win in order to stay alive! When Katniss Everdeen boldly takes her sister's place, now she must fight in the Hunger Games-a fight to death on live television. She knows she must win and will do ANYTHING it takes to win!
